

Contact Addendum for Project Photographs

The party providing track maintenance, construction, or improvement services ("Contractor") covered by this contract or purchase order ("Contract") and the contracting railroad ("Railroad") hereby agree to the following additional Contractor requirements:

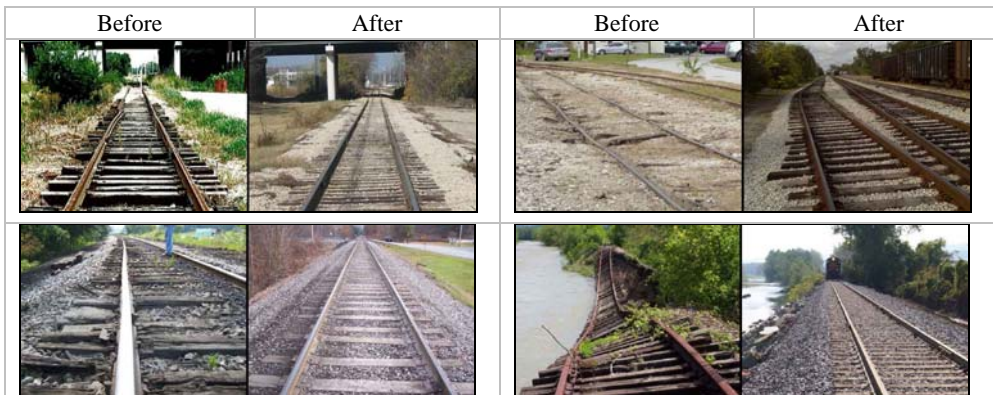
1. Contractor shall secure a digital photograph of tracks, bridges, rail, roadbed, crossings, or other assets ("infrastructure") that demonstrates overall infrastructure condition BEFORE work commences.
2. Contractor shall secure a digital photograph of infrastructure that demonstrates overall infrastructure condition AFTER work is completed. (See examples below.)
3. Contractor shall secure the digital photographs described in paragraph 1 and 2 from roughly the same position to allow a comparison of infrastructure condition before and after work is completed.
4. Photographs shall be high-resolution, print-quality digital images. Photographs from most popular digital cameras should suffice.
5. Contractor shall e-mail photographs to shortlinetrackphotos@gmail.com with the following:
 - a. Name of Contractor company, a contact name, and a contact phone number;
 - b. Name of the Railroad, and the name and contact information of the Contract manager or other point of contact for Railroad;
 - c. Inclusions of the photographs as an attachment;
 - d. A brief description of the work conducted and its location; and
 - e. Any desired photographic attribution or credit line, such as the name of the photographer.

Contractor may also include a print-quality company logo which may displayed in conjunction with the photos. Contractor is encouraged to submit as many photos as necessary to demonstrate the results of its work. Please limit each e-mail to 20 MB of data. Use multiple e-mails if more than 20 MB of data must be sent.

6. All photographs submitted may be used by Railroad or the American Short Line and Regional Railroad Association ("ASLRRA") for any purpose. Contractor waives all rights to the photos. If Contractor hires a third-party photographer, Contractor will secure the release of rights to the photographs and hold Railroad and ASLRRA harmless for any action arising from the future use of the photographs.

7. The terms of this addendum will be satisfied upon receipt of the digital photographs at the e-mail address in paragraph 5, above. An electronic receipt will be provided from shortlinetrackphotos@gmail.com to the contacts listed in paragraph 5(a) and 5(b), above to verify satisfaction of this addendum.
